

From Acting President, Ed Hourigan

“The world hates change, yet it is the only thing that has brought progress” - Charles Kettering

I am very excited to be able to tell you about progress that will continue to strengthen the impact of our Pope John Paul II student-athletes.

The Pope John Paul II High School Athletic Club (PJPAC) has been formed with the purpose of organizing and mobilizing the school community around athletics for the benefit of our school, student-athletes, staff, and family members, so that each student may be treated fairly and be provided with an exceptional high school athletic experience. The PJPAC will be responsible for fundraising, and outreach to the athletic community (CYO/Alumni). To date many team boosters have been operating independently, which shows the desire for participation to raise funds and host events to support our Panthers.

Through the formation of the PJPAC we will be able to create economies of scale in order to maximize our fundraising efforts as well as negotiate price points for volume purchases.

In the past, there were concerns over independent team support groups not being properly credentialed, supported, and informed to raise funds and organize events. The formation of the PJPAC will provide us with the necessary oversight to ensure each of these concerns are properly addressed.

Keeping these thoughts in mind all, athletic fundraising will now be run through the PJPAC. This idea was tested last year, and the independent booster clubs did an excellent job of coming together, combining funds, and deciding what would best benefit all of our student-athletes. Our major accomplishments last year included new weight room equipment (2 half racks, lifting platform, 3 flat to 90 benches) as well as 32 new cushioned team bench chairs for volleyball, basketball, and wrestling. This proved to us that with the right people in place, we could work together and have a greater impact.

There have been several meetings to date for the purpose of creating a structure to the PJPAC. The most recent meeting was held on Thursday, October 13th where officers were selected. Ed Hourigan is the President of the PJPAC, Kimm Galbraith is the Treasurer. We are still in need of a Vice President and Secretary. If you are interested in serving in either of these roles please contact Ed Hourigan or Nicole McMullen.

Collectively the group has set a list of priorities where the funds raised will be spent. The items in order of priority are 1) Senior Gifts; 2) Senior Recognition; 3) End of Season Team Event; 4) Weight Room Improvements.

There have been several fundraising events already this year and additional functions and items are in the works. Committees have been formed for fundraising and split into two categories, major and minor. We will need the support and assistance of everyone. Please consider joining the PJPAC at our next monthly meeting, Thursday, November 17th at 7:00 PM to learn how you can join one of the committees. In addition to the fundraising committees there are committees for Senior Gifts, Green Team / Field Crew, CYO, and Marketing & Communication. Keep the words of Pope John Paul II in mind as you reflect on your ability to join us, “The future starts today, not tomorrow.”
