THE SCHOOL

Pope John Paul II is a four-year co-educational Roman Catholic High School and one of 17 secondary schools operated under the auspices of the Archdiocese of Philadelphia. Pope John Paul II High School is the merger of St. Pius X High School in Pottstown and Kennedy Kenrick High School in Norristown, both of which closed in June of 2010. Founded in 2010, the school serves grades 9-12.
